The **CHC33021 Certificate III in Individual Support (Ageing and Disability)** is designed to provide training to entry level workers who want to work in the community to provide personalised support to people in an aged and disability setting.

**Course start date:** Monthly intakes

### Course Duration:

Up to 39 weeks. You can fast track your course in a shorter time frame (dependent on student's skills and knowledge)

### Course Delivery:

- Online
- 120 hours Vocational Placement is required to complete the course. Students must obtain and submit a current police check prior to placement at the students expense. Students are required to source their own placements.

### Entry Requirements:

- A student must be able to supply a Federal Police Check (cost applies) on enrolment - refer to [www.afp.gov.au](http://www.afp.gov.au) for fees.
- Regular access to a computer or tablet to undertake learning and assessment activities
- Regular access to the internet and to an email account
- The ability to communicate directly with SRI
- The ability to communicate in English with SRI
- The ability to understand instructions provided, written or verbally in English
- The ability to use a computer and type
- The willingness to provide a valid USI
